Italy is responsible for about one-fifth of the world's wine production (which comes to about 8 billion bottles a year, give or take...). No other country on earth has the variety of indigenous grape varieties as found in Italy, either. (Several hundred have been "officially" cataloged...) And take into consideration over 4,000 years of winemaking history, it's a wonder... A sometimes confusing wonder... So we've split things up a bit, according to region...
